State reports 11 new COVID-19 cases for Juneau

The Alaska Department of Health and Social Services (DHSS) reports <u>11 new residents</u> in the Juneau community identified with COVID-19 for December 3.

Please note: Starting this Monday, December 6, the <u>DHSS cases dashboard</u> will update three times a week – on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays – and DHSS will begin issuing its COVID-19 summary emails only on those days as well. To stay in line with DHSS's reporting schedule, the City and Borough of Juneau will issue COVID-19 case count updates – like what you're reading right now – only on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.

Statewide, DHSS reports <u>318 new people</u> identified with COVID-19 – 312 are residents and six are nonresidents. Alaska has had 146,558 cumulative resident cases of COVID-19 and a total of 5,426 nonresidents.
